No awards won and not critically acclaimed, just a good wine at a great price!

Cantastorie Pinot Grigio, Italy £15

175ml glass £3.95, 250ml glass £5.25

Fresh green apples and citrus on the palate with aromas of stone fruit.

Domaine la Serre Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc, France £17

175ml glass £4.50, 250ml glass £5.75

Wine has clear colour, a fresh bouquet with lemon and grapefruit tinges.

Vina Edmara Viognier, Central Valley, Chile £18

175ml glass £4.70, 250ml glass £6.25

Complex nose of ripe peaches, apricots and kiwi. Fruity and floral on the palate with a refreshing finish.

Chapel Down Flint Dry, Tenterden, Kent, England £20

175ml glass £5.10, 250ml glass £6.80

Predominantly Chardonnay grape. Aromas of zesty lemon, fresh green apple and white flowers.

Riverstone Ridge Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand £23

175ml glass £5.75, 250ml glass £7.75

Ripe gooseberry and citrus aromas, showing some tropical fruit and lime on the palate.

Puerta Vieja Rioja Blanco, Spain £22

100% Viura grape from the vineyards around Cenicero. Aromas of lime, apricot and peach which follow through onto the palate with a light floral aftertaste.

Lucien M Chablis, France £24

Using grapes from well-drained south-west facing slopes in the village of Beine. Unique flavours of citrus fruit and mineral notes.

Sauvion les Fondettes Sancerre, France £26

Bracingly acidic, and has pungent aromas of gooseberries, grass, nettles, and a hint of stony minerality.

2002 Thomas Hyland Chardonnay, Australia £32

Citrus and Honey dew on the palate with aromas of French oak, lemon zest, white peach and grapefruit.

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Marcel Martin Merlot, Pays d'Oc, France £15

175ml glass £3.95, 250ml glass £5.25

Easy drinking with an intense aroma of red fruit, this is very harmonious wine.

Colle Dei Vescovi Cabernet Sauvignon, Italy £17

175ml glass £4.50, 250ml glass £5.75

Outstanding aromas of blackberries, plums and black cherries, blended with hints of vanilla.

Red Anchor Shiraz, Australia £18

175ml glass £4.70, 250ml glass £6.25

A dry red with lots of ripe, dark berry fruits balanced with a touch of oak, producing a rich textured finish.

Vistamar Sepia Pinot Noir Reserva, Casablanca Valley, Chile £21

Bright ruby red colour with aromas of fresh raspberries and cherries. Fresh elegant flavours provide a fruity sensation.

Domaine de la Baume Syrah, Pays d'Oc, France £25

Notes of dark berry fruit, exotic spice and freshly ground pepper with expressive plum and blackberry flavours.

Monte Real Rioja Reserva, Spain £27

A silky smooth Reserva with layers of ripe strawberry and blackberry and a lovely savoury finish with fine oak in the background.

Don David Malbec Reserve, Cafayate Valley, Argentina £29

Aged in new barrels for 12 months. Aromas of red berries and plums and a palate of spice and vanilla.

Château des Combes St Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France £32

Wonderfully fragrant on the nose, and a palate of ripe wild berry fruit and dry backbone.

Chapel Down Union Red, Tenterden, Kent £35

Pinot Noir and Rondo grape. A soft medium bodied wine with flavours of red fruit, bramble and black pepper and aromas of plum and Kentish cherries.

Cantastorie Pinot Grigio, Italy

Beautiful rose in colour, this wine has a delicious aroma of strawberries and red berries.

Sierra Creek White Zinfandel, CA, USA

£18

Full of fruit aromas, light bodied and refreshing with flavours of red berries.

Chapel Down English Rose, Tenterden, Kent

£22

Aromas of strawberries and cream, raspberries and redcurrants. Palate is fresh and dry yet packed with red berry flavours leading to a crisp refreshing finish.

Champagne and Sparkling

Zonin Prosecco, Italy

200ml bottle £6.25

Light and lively with ripe pears and lemons rounded off with a hint of sweetness.

Louis Dornier et Fils Brut, Champagne

£32

Upfront biscuity elegance blends with respectful ageing in the bottle, a very stylish champagne.

Chapel Down Rose Brut, Tenterden, Kent

£42

Classic grape variety in a modern style, the colour, lightly smoked salmon. Wine is young, fresh and clean.

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut, Champagne

£55

Reflecting the traditions of the past, this is full, yet dry and has a creamy style with biscuity flavours.

Laurent Perrier Cuvee Rose Brut, Champagne

£72

The briefest Liaison with grape skins tantalisingly leaves this delicate colour yet exudes a floral fragrance evolving soft red berry richness.
